Addressing issues of exclusion and scarcity that arise from unequal power balances, which are key drivers of conflict, these can be ethnic, religious, and social economic.

Implementing interventions that build new systems and relationships to address structural causes of conflict like power inequities and cultural norms.

"I was a victim of discrimination because of my disability. Thanks to Shared Futures I was able to join a group of Muslim and Christian women.
